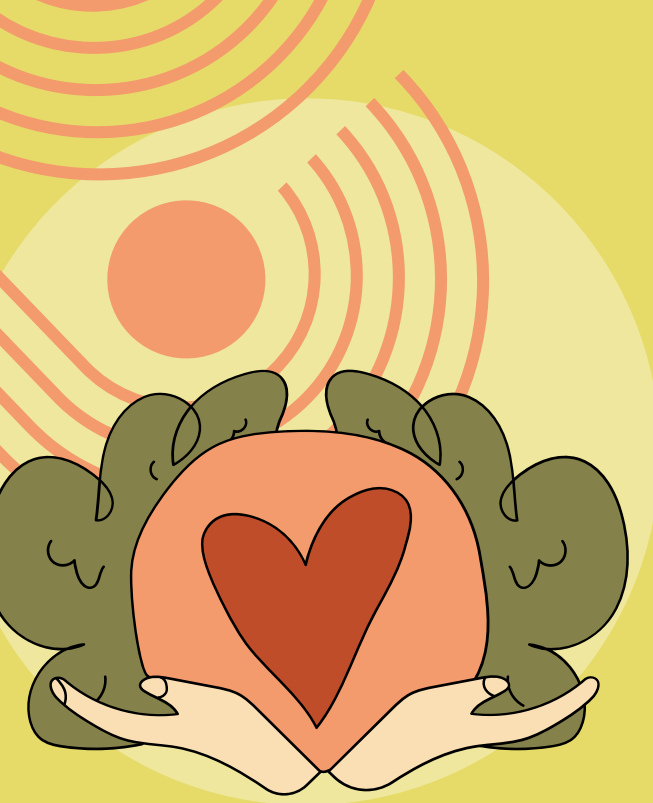

LOOKING AHEAD

Our current funding model isn't sustainable, and we're making some big changes to ensure a stronger future. We have some exciting news to share for our plans for next year!

Abortion Care Tennessee (ACT) and Mountain Access Brigade (MAB) are joining forces! We've been working together closely for a while now, and this merger is the next step in pooling our resources to better support Tennesseans needing out-of-state abortion care.

Starting August 25, 2025, the combined organization will kick off, and we're making some strategic moves in the meantime. To focus on growing and strengthening our impact, we'll be shifting away from some of our current funding methods. This will help us streamline operations and boost our ability to fund and support even more patients in the future.

This merger represents a huge milestone and a fresh start for us. By combining forces, we aim to double our impact and provide more funding, support, and advocacy to those who need it most.

We're excited about what's ahead and grateful for your continued support as we make these important changes!

2023/2024 HIGHLIGHTS

Of all the fun things that happened last fiscal year, these are some of our faves...

We transitioned our contracted staff to W2 Employees! That means they get healthcare, PTO, 401k's and all those other awesome quality of life things that everyone deserves.

We hired an Executive Director! Jules Edwards (they/them) is a Southern Appalachian activist with extensive experience in abortion advocacy, doula work, electoral campaigns, community safety, sex education, and transformative justice.

We beat our personal record of TN patients served! As abortion continues to be under attack in TN, it is more important than ever that local abortion funds exist. Abortion Forever, No Matter What!

We got to hang out with Chappell Roan and Olivia Rodrigo. Well, not like up close and personal, but we set up a table at their concert! And we gave out all the Plan B and Sex Ed kits our little hearts could muster.

With the help of Plan C Pills, we got a "Self-Managed Abortion" billboard put up outside of Knoxville! We care about a lot of things, but mostly, we care that people KNOW THEIR OPTIONS.

NAVIGATING THE LEGAL LANDSCAPE IN TN

Abortion Access in Tennessee

Tennessee is under one of the most extreme abortion bans in the country, with only narrow exceptions in cases of life endangerment of the pregnant person. However, abortion funds and advocacy groups in Tennessee are on your side! We're here to help you know where to go for care, as well as to help you get the funding you need for your appointment. For more information on self-managing your abortion at home, keep reading!

Travel Ban for Minors

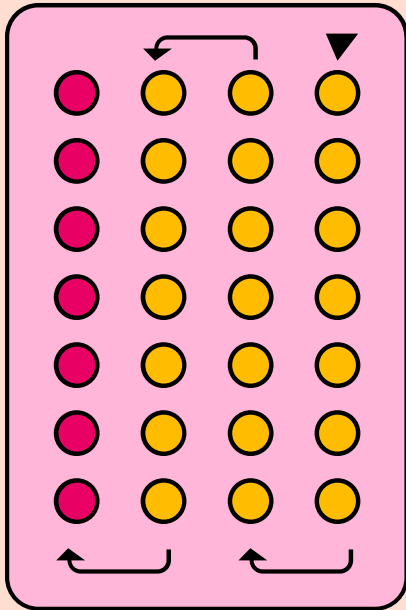
Tennessee law requires notarized parental consent for minors receiving abortion-related assistance. For guardians aiding their children, abortion funds have Consent Form Templates for notarization. Expect to provide ID and proof of guardianship during this process. Additionally, abortion funds can assist in connecting you with virtual TN notaries, in-person notary services are also available at public libraries, UPS, and FedEx offices.

Abortion Disinformation in Schools

In Tennessee, teachers can't discuss options beyond abstinence or provide abortion referrals. A new law mandates a misleading anti-abortion video in schools. Research shows such laws only increase stigma without helping teens make informed decisions. To combat this, offer accurate information, be a trusted resource, and advocate against anti-abortion propaganda in schools.

SELF-MANAGED ABORTION (SMA)

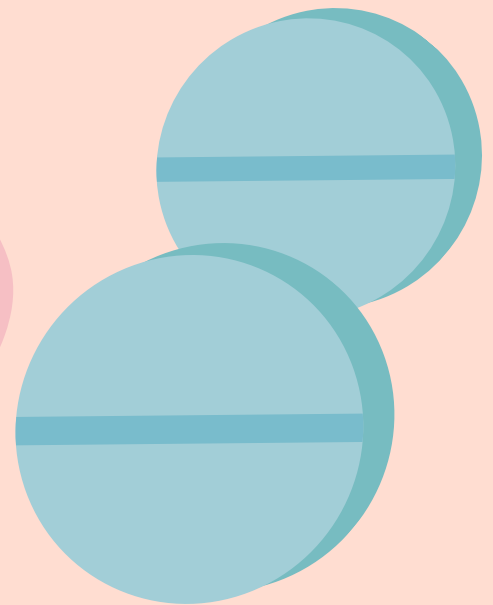
In Tennessee, you can still get pills through the mail!

SAY ABORTION. Show you are a safe person by using the word "abortion" and including everyone, such as trans and non-binary individuals, in your advocacy. Use inclusive language.

Demand Access & Expansion

Register to Vote: Focus on state and local elections. Check your registration and register if needed.

Fight Voter Suppression: Oppose voter disenfranchisement and push for expanded voting options.

Support Insurance Coverage: Ask legislators to ensure \$0 copays for abortion care and comprehensive insurance coverage.

Advocate for Legislation: Support bills protecting abortion providers and contact your representatives to advance these measures.

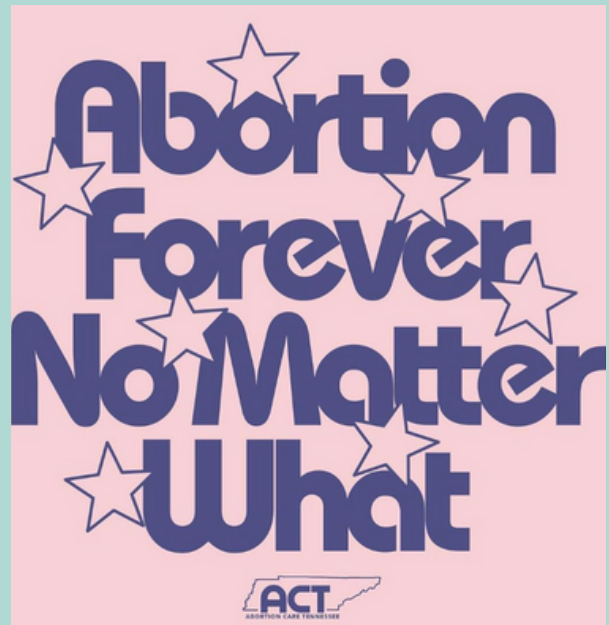
Dear Gentle Reader,
