At Abortion Care TN & Mountain Access Brigade, we are working hard to dismantle the systemic barriers that prevent our communities, especially those most marginalized, from living safe, self-determined lives.

That means fighting for healthcare, racial and economic justice, queer and trans liberation, and the right to parent (or not) in safe, supported environments.

Over the past year, we've witnessed Tennessee act as a testing ground for some of the country's most dangerous attacks on bodily autonomy, marginalized communities, and families.

In response, ACT and MAB have expanded abortion access support, deepened our relationships with our community, and built new spaces for education and resistance.

This report shares our impact from July 2024 to June 2025. Inside, you'll find the challenges we've faced, how we've responded, and what we've built alongside our community. It's a reflection, a record, and a promise: **we will continue to move forward rooted in care, and committed to collective liberation.**

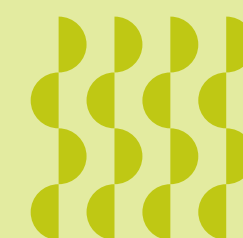
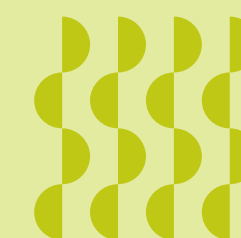
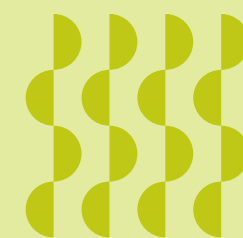
ABOUT MAB

WHO WE ARE

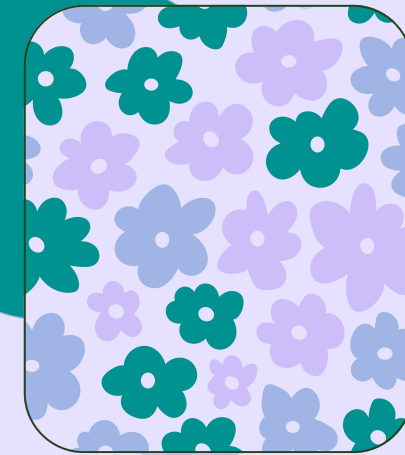
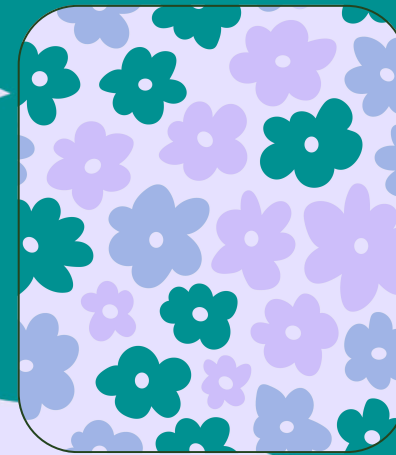
We are an all-volunteer group of abortion doulas based in Tennessee who are passionate about helping others receive care. A doula is a non-medical professional trained to provide support for people during a major medical experience, including assisting them through miscarriage or abortion. (All of our Doulas use the alias “Katie” to protect the anonymity of the people doing this work on the ground).

OUR STORY

Originally founded in 2016 as the Knoxville Abortion Doula Collective, we transformed in 2020 into Mountain Access Brigade to better serve the increasing need for financial support across the state. We use our secure support line to help clients navigate decision-making, appointment logistics, and other difficulties.



OUR PURPOSE



Tennessee has become one of the most hostile states for reproductive healthcare. Abortion is completely banned with next to no exceptions. Criminalization of pregnancy outcomes is increasing. Healthcare providers are refusing care under discriminatory “moral conscience” laws. And marginalized people, especially young folks, BIPOC communities, and LGBTQ+ Tennesseans, face the harshest consequences.

We see our funding and programs as a direct intervention to state violence and harm. Because everyone deserves access to abortion. Everyone deserves care. Everyone deserves to live with autonomy and dignity. We’re fighting to make this a reality for ALL Tennesseans.

A NOTE FROM OUR BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Dear friends and supporters,

This past year in Tennessee has been hard. There have been more attacks on our bodily autonomy, more bans, and more politicians trying to control us, but we are still here! We are still fighting, and we refuse to be silenced.

Here's towards a better world, built together.

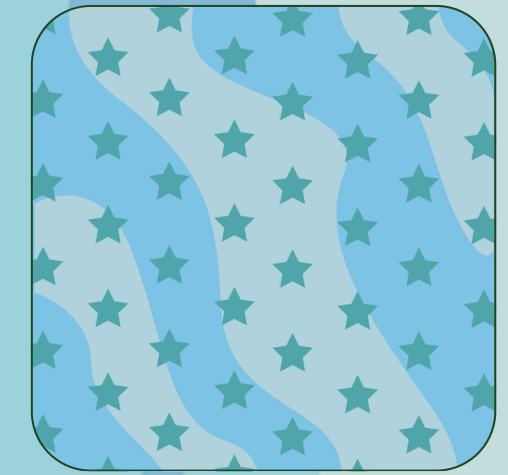

ABOUT OUR FUNDING MODELS

Our models are built on trust, relationship, and a deep commitment to community care. In a time of ongoing attacks on abortion access, we've built out funding models that are values-aligned, and rooted in sustainability. We fund abortions and build ecosystems of support to meet this moment and the next.

Through grassroots donations, major gifts, and unrestricted grants, we're able to move resources quickly and equitably. Every Tennessean is eligible for our services, no matter where they live or what they're up against. This model allows us to center people over institutions, care over control, and community over bureaucracy, because we know our collective liberation can't wait.

OUR FUNDING MODELS



MERGER AND SUPPORT LINE

In 2025, ACT became the official fiscal sponsor of Mountain Access Brigade (MAB), expanding our infrastructure and deepening our direct support across the state. MAB operates a warm line for Tennessee patients seeking abortion care, staffed by trained abortion doulas Monday through Friday.

Our funding tiers are guided by clinic appointment costs to ensure equitable and consistent support, and our funding pledges are sent directly to the clinic from our support team. The warm line currently offers support in English, Spanish, and Portuguese and can be reached via call or text at **855-888-6228**.

BLOCK GRANTS

To reach as many Tennessee patients as possible, ACT provides quarterly block grants to trusted neighboring clinics who see the highest volume of traveling Tennesseans.

Our funding agreements include a request for basic, non-identifying demographic data to help us track the impact of our funding and respond to emerging community needs. We encourage clinics to fund patients using MAB's pledge tiers when possible. Any person living in Tennessee is eligible for our funding.

To access this support, patients should ask the clinic they're going to about funding from ACT.

EMERGENT FUNDING

For the first time ever, ACT and MAB are now sharing a flexible, pooled budget to fully fund high-need cases, including: TN minors, survivors of domestic or interpersonal violence, houseless folks, and undocumented people--vulnerable Tennesseans who often face the greatest barriers to getting care.

This allows us to respond quickly, equitably, and compassionately, without forcing vulnerable patients to navigate a complex system without support. Though we are piloting this budget this year, we hope to grow it in the future in order to be in deeper alignment with our values.

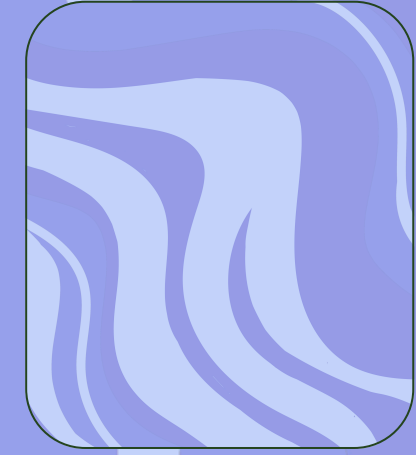

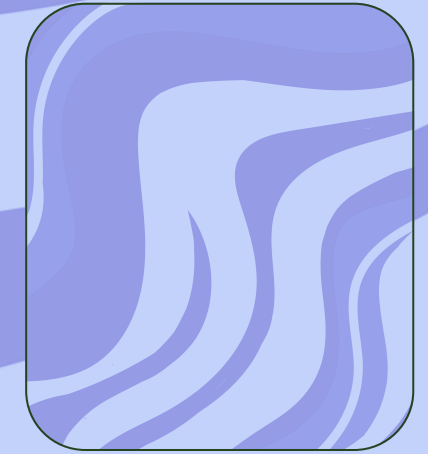

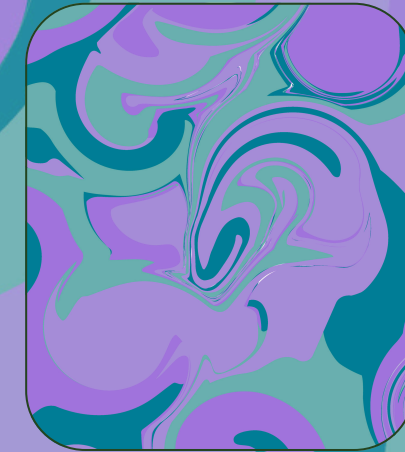
MAB LAST YEAR, BY THE NUMBERS

- Grants from Other Nonprofits: 16%

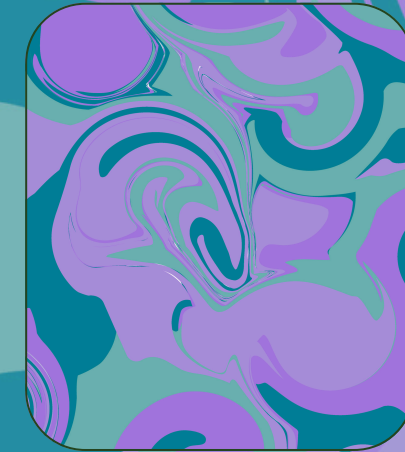

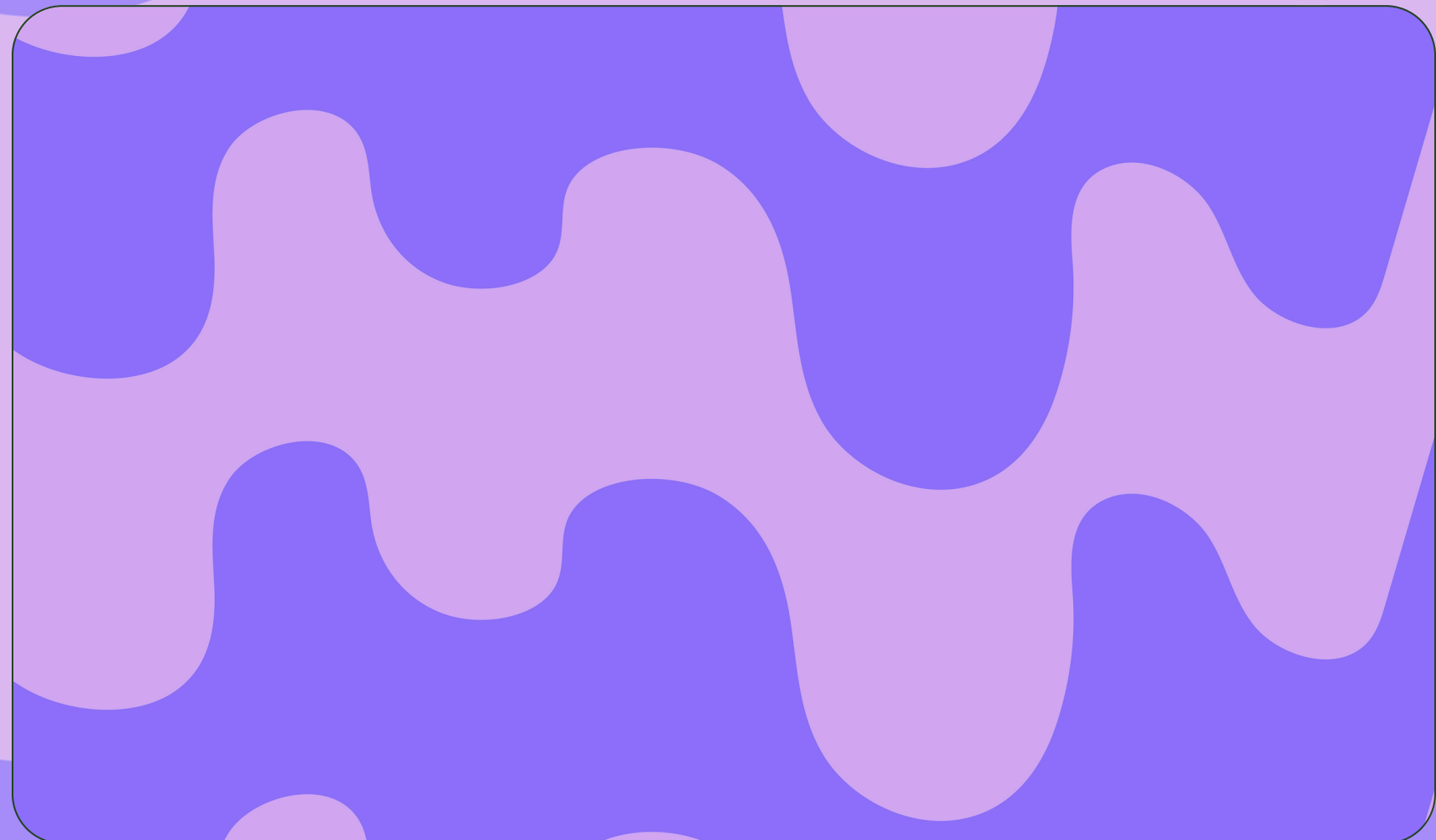

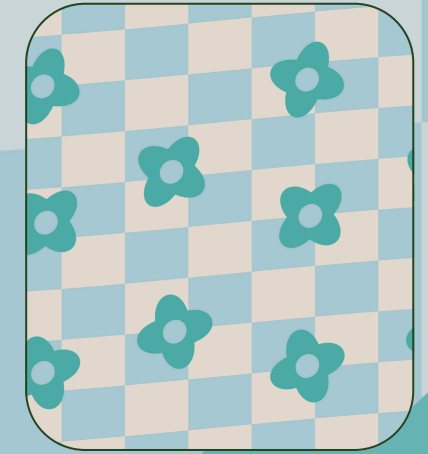
RESOURCE DISTRIBUTION



ACT provides free emergency contraception, pregnancy tests, and ovulation tests to community partners across Tennessee, including LGBTQ+ youth centers, sex worker collectives, college campuses, mutual aid groups, nonprofits, retail shops, and at public tabling events. Right now, our distribution network is strongest in Nashville, with smaller programs in Memphis and Knoxville, and with plans to expand into more rural areas across the state, especially those facing reproductive healthcare deserts.

This work meets people where they are, creating low-barrier access to essential reproductive health supplies without cost or stigma. It's part of our larger harm-reduction strategy and commitment to care that's rooted in trust, autonomy, and community.

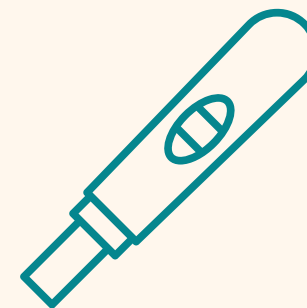
ACT LAST YEAR, BY THE NUMBERS



WHERE OUR RESOURCES GO (REPRO DISTRO PROGRAM)



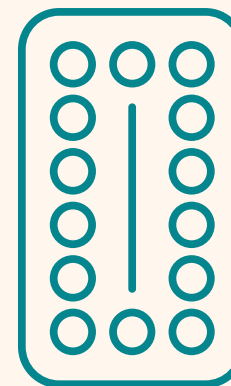

'25-'26 GOALS

In our merger with Mountain Access Brigade, we've been able to take major steps forward. We began to pay our doulas, who have held this work with love and labor for years, and we launched Spanish-language support on our abortion line to move closer to true language justice. Now, we're building on that momentum with bold goals for the year ahead.

Expanding Caller Services:

We're committed to making our warm line a trusted, safe resource for trans callers. That means we're developing new services tailored to their experiences, training doulas on where gender-affirming clinics and providers are outside of Tennessee, and partnering with trans-led organizations to ensure our support is community-centered and rooted in trust.

Launching a Community Advisory Board:

This year, we're forming a Community Advisory Board made up of clinic partners, our volunteers, and community partners to help guide our work with honesty and transparency. We want to stay deeply connected to the people we serve and create clear channels for feedback, accountability, and shared decision-making.

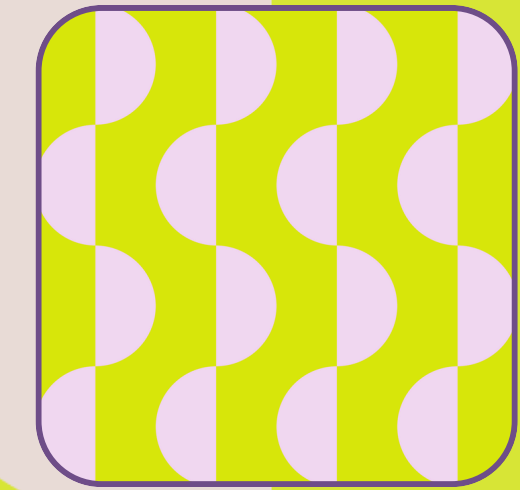
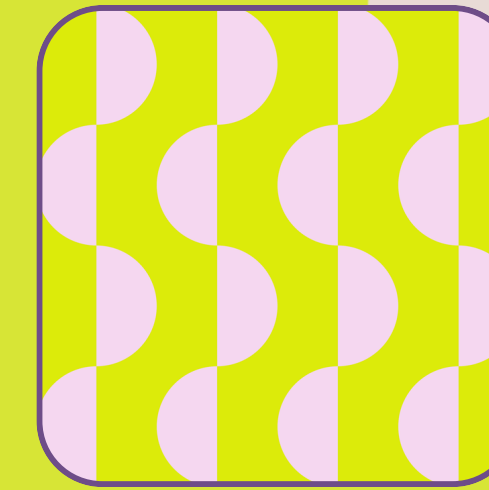
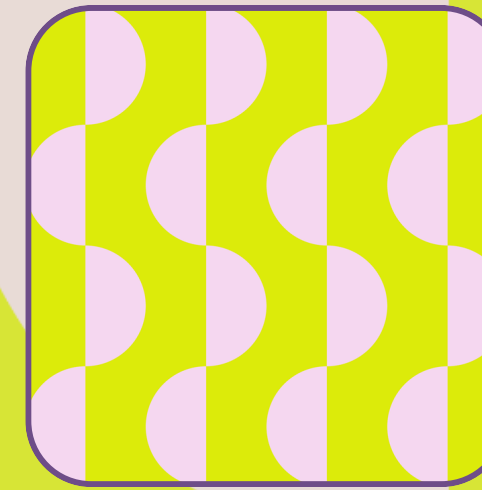
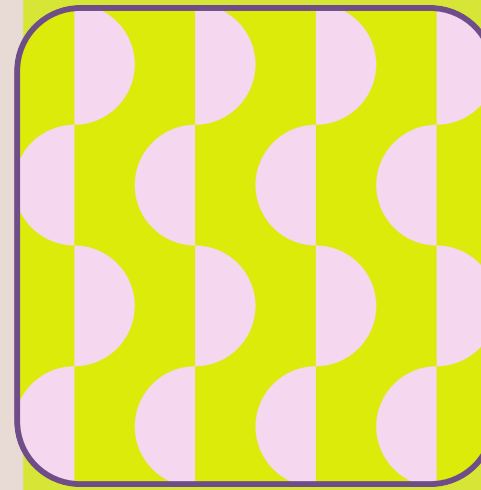
Growing Our Volunteer & Leadership Programs:

Our work has always been powered by dedicated people like you. We plan to expand our volunteer roles, improve training and coordination, and grow our Board of Directors to include more voices from across Tennessee. As our organization grows, so must our leadership and care infrastructure to prevent burnout.

Distributing \$500,000 in Direct Funding Support from ACT & MAB combined:

We aim to give out at least \$500,000 in abortion funding this year—our highest goal yet. With your support, we can fully fund more patients, especially those facing the steepest barriers to care, and meet the rising demand for our services equitably, and with dignity and consistency.

- Educating our community and each other through trainings and book clubs

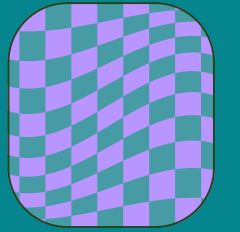
