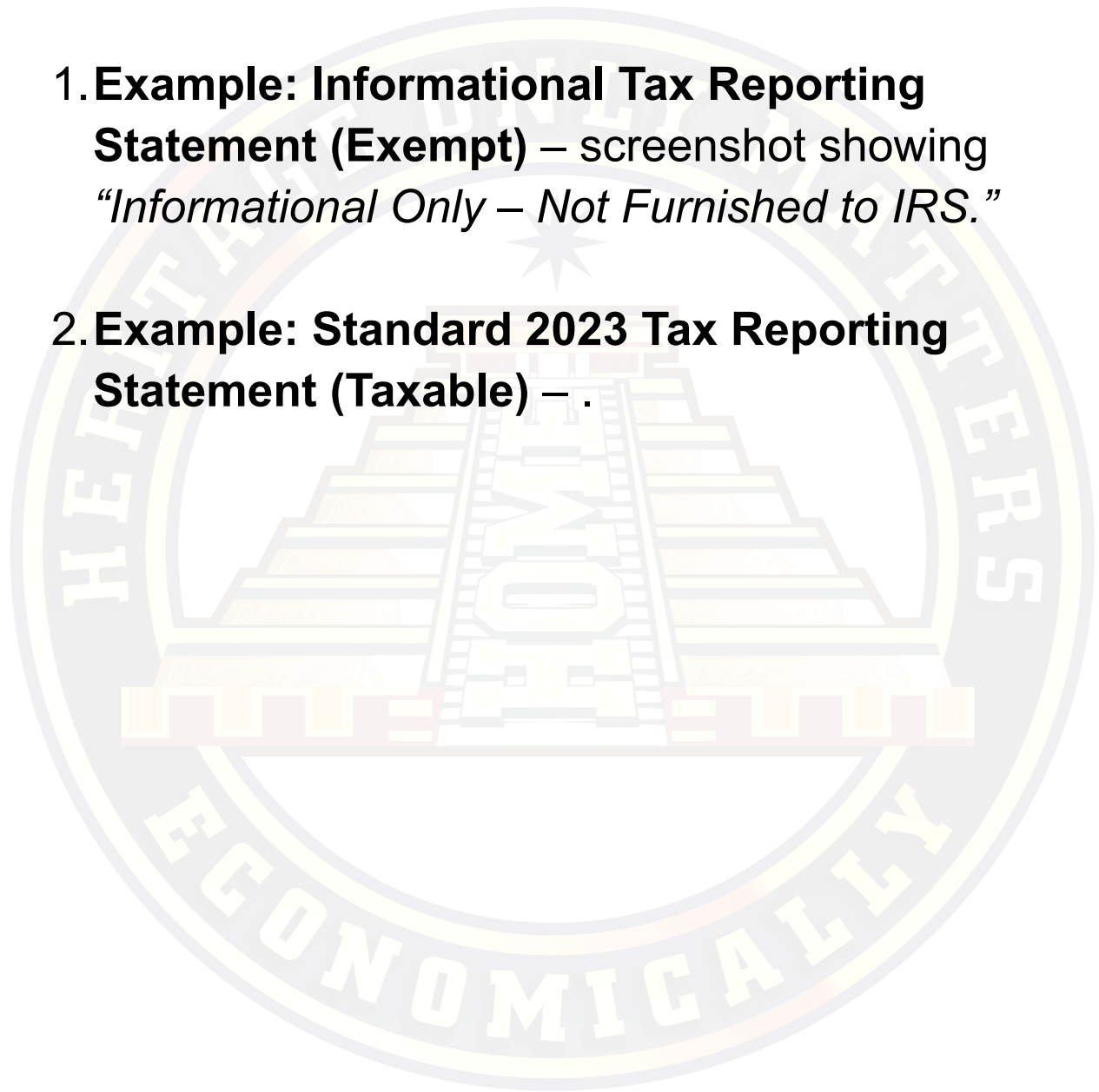

Section 7 Employment & Tax Exemption (Optional for Nationals)

While opening a **tribal business account** guarantees exemption from corporate gains tax, some Nationals may also extend their tax-exempt status to **wages from employment**. This process requires updating employment records to reflect tribal nationality and presenting acceptable identification.

How It Works

- Nationals may update their **I-9 Employment Eligibility Verification Form** with both their government name and tribal name.
- Supporting documentation includes:
 - **Tribal Identification Card** issued by the Aboriginal Republic of North America (ARNA).
 - **Updated Social Security Card** reflecting the tribal name.
 - **Certificate of Tribal Nationality & Citizenship**.
- Employers are legally required to accept these documents as valid proof of work authorization under federal guidelines.

Demonstrated Example

In our case demonstration, a National successfully:

- Submitted an updated **I-9** signed under both their government name and tribal name.
- Presented tribal ID and updated Social Security card.
- Had their employer re-verify employment status without issue, honoring the exemption.

Transcript excerpt:

"I showed them my Native American tribal identification and my updated Social Security card with my tribal name on it. The employer accepted my new status and updated their records. From that point forward, my wages were treated as exempt."

Important Disclaimer

Employment tax exemption is **not universally guaranteed**:

- **Guaranteed:** Tribal business accounts and entrepreneurship.
- **Conditional:** Payroll wages through an employer, as acceptance varies by company and jurisdiction.

This makes entrepreneurship the most reliable path, while employment exemption can be pursued case by case.

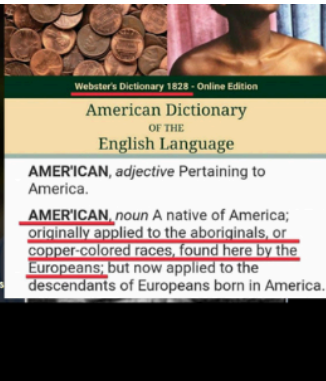
