This year, 2026, I will turn 70 years old. I know and have known many people who have lived well past 70 years, and yet somehow, I have failed to imagine myself among them. I know that I am not alone in this. It seems that the older most people get, the less comfortable they are with imagining themselves to be "old."

And yet, to have the opportunity to grow old is considered to be a privilege and one of God's great blessings. The Bible is particularly affirming of the value of "old age." However, the "value" of getting older often includes an important caveat of continuing in righteousness and usefulness.

Psalm 84 says of the righteous:

¹⁴ *They will still bear fruit in old age, they will stay fresh and green.*

In Titus chapter 2, Paul encourages Titus to challenge older men to lead by example:

² *Teach the older men to be temperate, worthy of respect, self-controlled, and sound in faith, in love and in endurance.*



This is not only true of individuals, it is also true of congregations and churches. While no relevant and life-filled church wants to see itself as "old," there is great value in the longevity and maturity of a spiritual community. While the appeal of the "it's-all-happening-right-right-here-at-the-shiny-new-thing-that's-unlike-any-of-those-old-things" mojo is worn off, the more valuable appeal of "we've-been-there-and-done-that-and-we've-seen-some-things," mojo remains. And this is the stuff of which life-long bonds are built, and multi-generational communities are grown.

In light of the 2,000 year history of the 'Capital C' Church, Riverbend is comparatively embryonic. Yet locally, by comparison, Riverbend is one of the most established and well-tenured large churches in the greater Austin area. In just 3 years, in 2029, Riverbend will enter the second half of its first century.

There is no reason for us to imagine that in the next 50 years we will not see God increase and multiply the engagement, enthusiasm, excitement and fruitfulness that has been true of Riverbend's first 50 years. God did not raise up this family of faith to impact and influence a single generation. In fact, I believe that we can confidently say that the first 50 years of Riverbend's impact was simply one generation's preparation for the even greater opportunities ahead for the coming generations in the next 50 years.

When I imagine myself at 70 years old, I do not imagine myself as someone who is even close to done. In fact, it is my belief and strong conviction that these 70 years have simply been the set-up and the preparation for the best that is yet-to-come. I haven't lived this long or worked with this much enthusiasm to imagine that I will miss the party we've all worked so hard to be a part of.



Faith, Friends, and The Rockies: The Week That Changes Everything

How Riverbend's Summer Camp Builds Community and Shapes the Next Generation

The mission of Riverbend Student Ministry is to help students Discover, Deepen, and Deploy the Good News about Jesus. One of the most meaningful ways we pursue that mission is by taking students each year to Student Camp in Estes Park, Colorado. More than a change of scenery, camp provides an intentional environment where students can encounter God and take real steps forward in their faith. Whether a student is just beginning to explore who Jesus is, or is ready to live out the Gospel with greater boldness, camp offers a place for them to grow.

Youth Pastors Reyn Harpole and Delaney Estes have seen the transformational impact of this trip on countless students. Many return home with renewed hope, a clearer sense of purpose, and a deeper desire to follow Jesus. Some even go on to influence their families, schools, and communities because of what God began in them during their week in Colorado. Camp creates space for moments that stay with students for the rest of their lives. These moments are shaped by passionate worship, Biblical teaching, meaningful conversations, and unhurried time together in the beauty of the mountains.



Students also come to camp looking for genuine community. Throughout the week, they develop real friendships that continue long after they return home. These relationships are formed through shared experiences, laughter, and the simple joy of being surrounded by people who truly care. At camp, students are supported by adult leaders who love Jesus and are committed to investing in the next generation. These leaders walk with students, encourage them, pray for them, and help them navigate the questions and challenges they face.

Student Camp is designed to equip students to live out their faith in their everyday lives. As they encounter the love of Jesus in a personal way, they head home ready to share that love in their schools,

homes, teams, and spheres of influence. Youth Pastor Reyn Harpole describes it this way: "Youth Camp changed the trajectory of my life forever, and I have made it my mission to help as many teenagers as possible have that same experience."

Whether you are already involved in Riverbend Youth or not, coming with us to camp is an incredible opportunity for any teenager, and all are welcome!
