Member Range Rental and Use Policy

Section 1. Folsom Shooting Club Statement

1. It shall be the policy of Folsom Shooting Club and the Board of Directors to allow voting members access to any and all ranges under the direction and control of the Club.
2. This policy does not prohibit the implementation of rules and procedures designed to assure the safe and efficient use of Club property.
3. Range personnel, whether paid or sanctioned club member volunteers, may exercise their judgment to assure that all Club property is being safely and properly used.
4. Voting members have the absolute right to address any grievance with the Board at any Board meeting or by giving notice to the Secretary 60 days prior to the Annual General Membership Meeting should the voting member wish to address the general membership

Section 2. Voting Members and Guests Obligations

1. Reservations

- a. Voting members agree to reserve a range/bay as far in advance as practical, but in no event shall a member make reservations more than 2 months in advance.
- b. Reservation requests for the same day or made after 5:00 PM for the following day will not be accepted.
- c. Range reservations shall be made by using the reservation request form located on the SVSC web page at the calendar link.
- d. Voting members may cancel reservations without penalty if the cancellation is made in writing to reservations@sacvalley.org no less than 24 hours in advance of the reservation.
- e. Voting members shall forfeit his or her reservation if they do not check in at the Main Range Office within one hour of the start of the scheduled range reservation. This will be considered a no call/no show and the reserved range may be given to another voting member or client.
- f. Voting members agree if they fail to use the range during their scheduled time slot the voting member will pay for the range in full at current voting member rates.
- g. Voting members agree that repeated no call/no show occurrences may result in the loss of reservation privileges. To restore reservation privileges the voting member shall personally present a petition to restore privileges to the Board of Directors at any regularly scheduled board meeting.
- h. SVSC Management may waive the cancellation requirement if, in Managements sole opinion, the range(s) are unavailable or unsafe due to weather, maintenance or any other reason beyond the control of the SVSC. Return of fees, if any, is the sole remedy available to the voting member for a reservation cancellation.
- i. While voting members may request a particular range or bay, SVSC reserves the right to reassign voting members to any range or bay adequate to the voting member's intended use.

- j. Voting members are permitted to reserve a maximum of two (2) weekend time slots per calendar month.
- k. Range rental is restricted to AM or PM slots, no full day reservations will be accepted other than for training courses and sanctioned club events. Voting members who fail to check in at the Main Range Office within one hour of the reservation shall be considered a no show/no call and will forfeit the reservation.

2. Range use

- a. Voting members are limited to four guests per membership. If a voting member and spouse have two separate voting memberships, both voting members may have four (4) unrelated guests.
- b. Voting members must remain with their guests at all times while on the range.
- c. Voting members are responsible for guests or individuals using the range as part of the voting member's activities.
- d. Voting members shall properly orient all guests or individuals using the range as part of the voting member's activities as to all safety and range policies.
- e. Voting members shall reimburse SVSC for expenses and or repair costs of all damaged property when loss or damages result from misuse or negligent acts of the voting member, guests or individual's using the range as part of the voting member's activities.
- f. Voting members shall to the fullest extent of the law, reimburse, indemnify and hold SVSC and the Folsom Shooting Club harmless from and against any claims, liabilities, losses, damages, costs, expenses including reasonable attorney's fees, awards, fines or judgments arising by reason of the death or bodily injury to persons, injury to property, or other losses, damages or expenses, including any of the same resulting from SVSC alleged or actual negligent act or omission, regardless of whether such act or omission is active or passive, arising from the voting member's use or activities at the range.
- g. Voting members shall assure all participants, use proper eye and ear protection. This protection shall be worn at all times when firearms are being discharged.
- h. Voting members shall collect and dispose of all trash generated each day. Ranges are to be left clear of all expended cases, hulls, unused ammunition, targets, props and other materials at the end of each day.
- i. Voting members shall immediately report any injury to management.
- j. Voting members shall immediately report catastrophic failure of any firearm to management, regardless of lack of injury.
- k. Voting members shall immediately report fire to Range staff.
- l. Voting members shall not permit Media to enter SVSC property for anything other than personal use. The media is strictly forbidden from performing interviews, taking photographs, creating any video images, drawings or recording any person or anything on SVSC property without the prior written consent of the Folsom Shooting Club Board of Directors.
- m. Voting members shall ensure all guest, family members and observers check in at the Main Range Office and sign the "Range Waver" prior to reporting to the voting member's reserved range. If the voting member has multiple days reserved, the waver must be signed each day

prior to reporting to the range. Guest, family members and observers will not be allowed on the reserved range until the voting member is present.

- n. Voting members shall have all steel target(s) approved by Management prior to use.
- o. At no time shall voting members allow any item to be used as a target that may be considered hazardous waste or may leave unsafe debris behind. This includes but is not limited to:
 - Computers
 - Monitors
 - CRT's
 - Televisions
 - Ceramic objects (standard clay pigeons are acceptable)
 - Appliances
 - Electronics
 - Glass of any kind

SVSC hereby:

- a. Grants voting members authority to conduct practice or recreational activities contracted herein without undue interference. However, SVSC retains full authority to alter or stop completely any part of any activity which, in the opinion of SVSC, is unsafe to either persons or property.
- b. SVSC retains the right to eject any member, guest or observer or other participants from SVSC premises for any reason, including but not limited to, failure to observe safety rules, range policies or instructions of range staff. All members must immediately comply with range staff instructions. Voting members may appeal range staff decisions to the Folsom Shooting Club Board of Directors.

3. Payment

- a. Full payment for range fees is due the day of rental.
- b. Voting members agree to pay a range restoration fee of up to \$150.00 per range and/or bay if, in the sole opinion of range staff, the member has failed to remove all debris, targets, target stands, hulls, ammunition cases, supplies or other materials from the rented range(s). It is the sole responsibility of the voting member to assure ranges are returned to their original cleanliness and serviceability.
- c. Management has authority to adjust restoration fees commensurate with severity and effort required to restore the rented facility to a serviceable condition.
- d. Voting members agree to notify range staff at the Main Range Office of unsatisfactory range conditions prior to the commencement of any shooting, practice or recreational activities. Once a voting member commences any activity on the assigned range or bay the voting member assumes responsibility and liability for the condition of the range or bay.
